The **SmartPhone** has more capability than a CellPhone. It runs a variant of Microsoft Mobile Edition designed for SmartPhones. It has some of the capabilities of Pocket PC 's but it lacks a full size 320x240 pixel screen, and touch-screen with stylus to support Pocket PC applications. This makes it impossible to run applications that are designed for the Pocket PC.

The **Pocket PC Phone** is a full feature Pocket PC with CellPhone functionality and ergonomics. It runs the Microsoft Pocket PC OS, has a 320x240 pixel screen, and a touch-screen with stylus like a Pocket PC. Most units have some form of QWERTY keyboard.
